

Water Restriction Levels by Council

In the Australian Capital Territory, ACTewAGL sets the water restriction level for the entire state, as well as Queanbeyan.

In New South Wales, Sydney Water sets the water restriction level for the Sydney metropolitan area and local councils set the water restriction level for its individual area.
