Overview

An Environmental Policy is a businesses' declaration of commitment to the environment. It should be used to highlight the organisation's objectives and targets and serve as the foundation of the Environmental Management Plan.

An Environmental Policy can be a stand-alone document or it can be integrated with your quality assurance, health and safety or other organisational policies. The Environmental Policy should be simple and understandable and should be communicated to all staff and customers. One way this can be achieved is by having the Policy displayed in the Reception area and staff room. This demonstrates that the business takes its corporate responsibility seriously.

Things that can be included in an Environmental Policy are:

- pollution prevention
- the need to comply with relevant legislation
- a commitment to continual improvement
- signature/s to show commitment from senior management.
