**Local holidays:** Local holidays are treated as public holidays for the purpose of Award entitlements. Therefore, part-time and full-time employees who would have ordinarily worked on the day that fell on the public holiday, have the right to have the time off with pay. The days listed will be updated as they are declared throughout the year. A part-time, full-time or casual employee working during such periods must be paid at public holiday penalty rates.
